CONSENT FOR THE SALT & LIGHT WEEKEND

The Salt & Light Project begins with a formation weekend for the young leaders, run by the Northampton Youth Ministry Office, on 13th - 15th October 2017 at the Monastery of Christ Our Saviour, Jacks Lane, Turvey, Bedfordshire, MK43 8DH (the monastery shares a site with Turvey Abbey). The weekend begins at 7.00pm on Friday & finishes at 2.30pm on Sunday.

The weekend involves: small group discussion & prayer, games & icebreakers, socialising as a group & mini-seminars on practical leadership skills. The young leaders will also take part in an organised, 2½ hour treasure-hunt in the village, whilst in a group with other young leaders. Young Leaders:

Young leaders participating in the salt & light weekend are asked:

1. Not to possess or use any illegal substances, alcohol, cigarettes or weapons of any kind.
2. To follow all schedules, rules, guidelines & emergency procedure of the programme & facility.
3. To socialise in public areas.
4. Not to hurt anyone verbally, emotionally, physically or in any other way.
5. To refrain from using swear words & language that others may find offensive.
6. To work towards making the weekend a good & safe time for everyone.
7. Not to bring valuables to the weekend, as the RC Diocese of Northampton will not take any responsibility for theft or any damage incurred.

surgical treatment, including anaesthetic or blood transfusion, as considered necessary by the medical authorities present.

6. If my child has any medical conditions (such as diabetes or epilepsy, or allergies) or other information that NYMO should be aware of, I will give details below. (Data Protection Act 1998 – information given will be used solely for the purpose for which it was given. It will be held confidentially, updated when appropriate, & destroyed when no longer required. Please note that NYMO’s adult leaders are not responsible for administering medication during this weekend. Please contact us if you have any concerns regarding medication)
